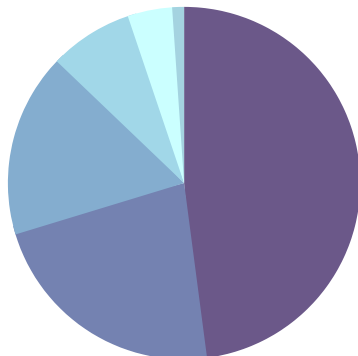

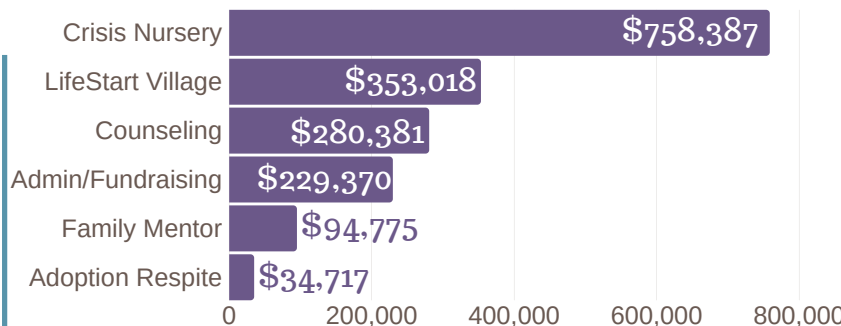


FINANCIALS

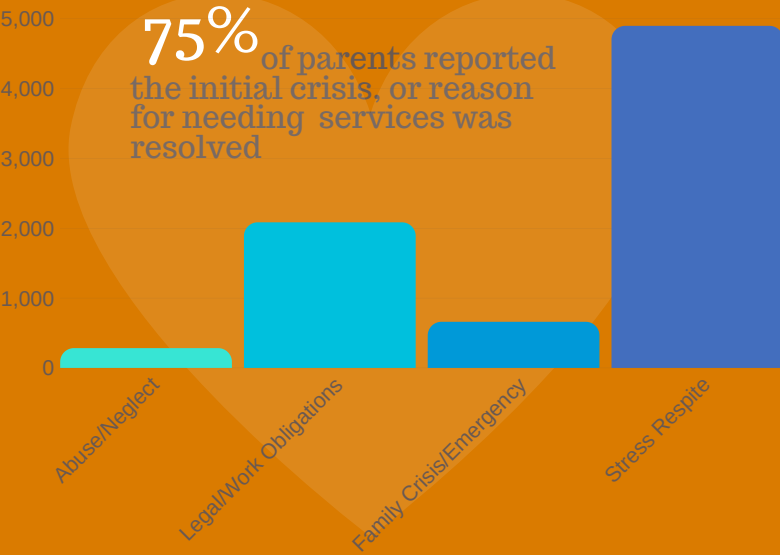

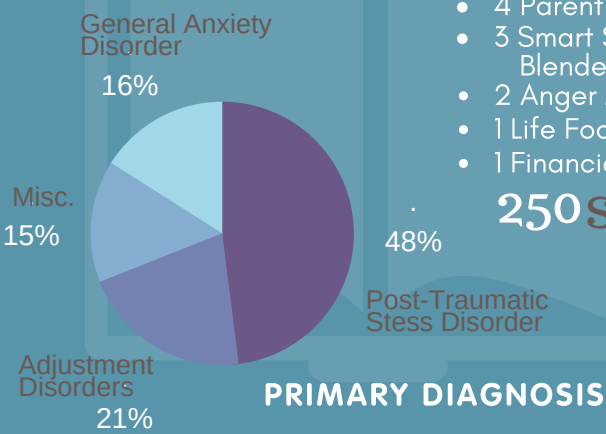
